WELCOME TO THE 2024-2025 TENNESSEE FEDERATION OF GARDEN CLUBS, INC SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM SUMMARY

All scholarships offered by Tennessee Federation of Garden Clubs, Inc., hereinafter referred to as TFGC, are one-year grants, which are available to Juniors, Seniors, Graduates, including Doctorial Students. Applications may be made by a sophomore for grants to be awarded for the junior year and after for other high levels. Three awards of \$1500 each, two awards of \$2250 each, or one award for \$4500 may be awarded each year or other combinations.

<u>PURPOSE:</u> TFGC is proud of its scholarship programs, which offers financial aid to students planning a career related to gardening, landscape design, environmental issues, floral design, or horticulture, etc. *The TFGC Scholarship Committee must approve any application made in any major other than the ones listed*Suggested Studies:

Wildlife Science Agronomy	Plant Pathology/Science

TERMS UNDER WHICH SCHOLARSHIPS ARE AWARDED:

- 1. Applications must be submitted on the required application form with all required additional information attached.
- 2. Applicant must be a legal resident of Tennessee but may be attending a qualified University/College anywhere in the United States.
- 3. Complete application must be mailed and emailed to the TFGC State Garden Club Scholarship Chairman, who must receive all applications no later than February 1st of each year. Applications received after that date will NOT be considered.
- 4. All applications will be judged by the TFGC Chairman/Committee in order to choose state winners. One (1) winning application may be sent to the Deep South Scholarship Chairmen by February 15 for consideration of a Deep South Garden Club, (DSGC), Scholarship. The DSGC Scholarship Committee will consider ONLY ONE application from each state. The website is www.deepsouthgardenclubs.com. Likewise, one winning application may be sent to National Garden Clubs, Inc. (NGC) by March 1 for consideration of a NGC Scholarship. The website is gardenclubs.org/college-scholarships.

Applicants must have at least a 3.25 GPA (on a 4.0 point scale) in order to apply. A complete official academic transcript, downloaded by the student is acceptable, which includes the latest grading period, must be included. The applicant must be a full time student as defined by TFGC: Twelve (12) Graded hours of classes for an undergraduate, Six (6) graded hours for post-graduate students. Graduate students must also submit complete transcripts for undergraduate courses.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

The following documents MUST be submitted:

(NOTE: Please Note Deadline: FEBRUARY 1, ONLY – One side of any forms/pages. Do not staple any forms/pag., Do not place the documents in page protectors or in any sort of permanent binde., All forms/pages must be typed or computer generated.

- TFGC Scholarship Application Form
- Financial Aid Form
- Completed official academic transcripts
- Personal Letter from Applicant (One page, front side only) (change font size and margins to accomplish)
- List of extracurricular activities, honors, recognitions received within the last three (3) years
- Two (2) Letters of Recommendations

All of the documents must be **mailed** in one large envelope and **emailed** by the applicant.

Applications must be mailed to the TFGC Scholarship Chairman Chairmen listed at the end of the application information.

When a student reapplies for a scholarship (whether the applicant is or is not a previous winner), a complete new and updated application must be submitted.

- 1. Scholarship funds WILL be sent to the Financial Aid Office of the University/College the student is attending. Checks will NOT be sent directly to students. Funds will be disbursed according to the particular school's term-system, unless the student has only one term remaining before the completion of the degree.
- 2. Funds may be disbursed only to students who are attending school full-time or as defined by TFGC.
- 3. Funds may be applied to studies overseas provided that the study is a condition of the recipient's degree plan and that payment continues to be made to the accredited U.S. University/College.
- 4. The student and Financial Aid Officer/Representative will determine how the money is to be spent: i.e. tuition, food housing, books, etc.
- 5. After the scholarship funds have been submitted to the University/College of the student's choice, it cannot be transferred to another university of college.
- 6. Must be planning a career related to gardening, landscape design, environmental issues, floral design, Horticulture, etc. Suggested Studies listed above.
- 7. In the event of a change in the student's major to one other than those listed above, or if the student withdraws from school, the balance of scholarship funds must be returned to the TFGC Scholarship Chairman.
